


Fundamental facts about Austria

- Austria especially plays an important role in connection with drug smuggling along the Balkan Route


Austria 1970 - 2010




Charges under the Drug Law/ Narcotics Act



2010 Austria




First delinquent/repeat offender



Federal Drug Coordination

- Responsibilites
 - Territorial coordination
 - Permanent information exchange and exchanges of views
 - Public relation
 - Austrian mission in international bodies
 - Preparation of ministerial business
 - Cut surface for national and international issues

Federal Drug Forum

Coordination between Federation and provinces

Federal Drug Forum

- Responsibilites
 - Dealing with fundamental questions of drug policy
 - Cooperation in drug prevention
 - Information exchange
 - Drafting of recommendations

The "Model of 4 Pillars"

- Pillar 1 Prevention
 - Primary prevention to prevent one's abusing drugs (e.g.personality development, leisure time activites)
 - Secundary prevention proposals for prevention and mentoring for drug addicts and high-risk groups


The "Model of 4 Pillars"

- Pillar 2 Drug addiction treatment (ambulant/inpatient) short and long term institutions (approx 200 in Austria)
- Pillar 3 Harm reduction (sanctions in the field of health and social welfare)
- Pillar 4 Law enforcement Supply reduction, combating international organised drug crime

Education and information

- Periodical training arrangements for police officers – information about drug market trends
- Annual meeting for police experts –
 information exchange between police, justice
 and health, experts from different fields
- Special trainings organised by reporting office "Precursor"

Possible cause of risks in the future

- Heroin and opiates from Afghanistan via Balkan Route
- Cocaine from South America via airports and increased via Balkan Route
- Synthetic drugs vom China available via internet forwarded via mail

Measures to combat international organised drug crime successfully

Key roles

- Enhancement of international operational cooperation (JIT's – Joint investigation teams, Europol, Eurojust, Interpol)
- Enhancement of international data exchange
- Enhancement of quality of <u>national</u> data- and information management

Primary activities

- Establishing contact network along the Balkan Route
- Conducting joint targeted operations- and investigations
- Setting up Joint Investigation Teams (JIT)

Key Data – participants

- 27 EU member states (Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Germany, Denmark, Estonia, Spain, Finland, France, United Kingdom, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Latvia, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Sweden, Slovenia, Slovakia)
- **3 candidate countries** (Croatia, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Turkey)
- Western Balkan countries (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Montenegro, Serbia)
- Further effected third countries (Switzerland, Ukraine, USA)
