

Legal basic: law integrated police force

- Art. 4 Minister of internal affairs and Minister of Justice make each 4 year a NSP
- Art 92 Federal police is responsible for the preparation of the NSP
- Art 4 & 7 NSP and motivated advice Fed Pol will presented to the Federal parliament




