

European Profile of the Outreach Workers in Harm Reduction

Outreach Worker in Harm Reduction (OWHR) (PrOWfile)

"Frontline Harm Reduction Workers in outreach settings paid or unpaid" (e.g. volunteers, peers, professionals, students). This definition includes such diverse outreach settings as party scenes, drug use settings, sex work and prison contexts.

Create a European and National input to OWHR recognition

European Profile of the Outreach Workers in Harm Reduction

WHY:

Effectiveness of outreach interventions depends greatly on the skills of the outreach workers, but...

- Limited training with focus on outreach work in the EU
- Sub-optimal employment conditions of outreach workers

Negative impacts on intervention results and service users







European Profile of the Outreach Workers in Harm Reduction

HOW:

The joint WHO, ILO and UNAIDS policy guidelines for improving health workers' access to HIV and TB prevention, treatment, care and support services, 2010;

The **ILO** Recommendation concerning HIV and AIDS and the World of Work, 2010 (No. 200);

The **EC** Council Recommendations on the prevention and reduction of health-related harm associated with drug dependence (2003).

EU 2020, Employment and Education, Agenda New Skills for New Jobs.

- 1. In-Country Diagnosis: Auscultation of Job Holders
- 2. Validation: Strategic and Experts Auscultations







European Profile of the Outreach Workers in Harm Reduction

HOW:

- 1. In-Country Diagnosis: Auscultation of Job Holders
- In-country diagnosis tool application by 11 European countries (171 participants)
- Different methods (e.g. questionnaires, interviews, etc.)
- **Diversity of participants** (e.g. professionals, peers, managers, somehow engaged in outreach work)
